ELECTROVAYA RECEIVES PURCHASE ORDER FOR BATTERY PACKS FOR ZERO EMISSION VEHICLES (“ZEV”)

Toronto, Ontario, October 30, 2007-- Electrovaya (TSX: EFL) today announced that it has received a Purchase Order (“PO”) for five battery packs for ZEVs from Miljobil Grenland AS (“Miljobil”).

Pursuant to the PO, Electrovaya will provide battery packs for five prototype ZEVs to be tested by Miljobil as part of its longer term plan to commercialize a pure electric vehicle in the Scandinavian countries. Miljobil's major shareholders, Skagerak Energy and Norsk Hydro, are among the largest energy companies in the world. Miljobil's objective is to contribute to the improvement of the regional environment by promoting the use of alternative power, including electric vehicles. Discussions are underway with Tata Motors to provide the gliders.

Mr. Oddbjørn Solum, President of Miljø Innovasjon AS, a wholly owned subsidiary company of Miljobil Grenland AS, says: “We are very pleased to work in cooperation with Electrovaya in the ZEV market, and we share Electrovaya’s vision of the importance of this initiative in Norway and other Scandinavian countries.”

Dr. Sankar Das Gupta, CEO of Electrovaya says: “Electrovaya previously completed a battery system and integration into a prototype ZEV for Miljobil. We are looking forward to our ongoing relationship with Miljobil and our collective commitment to the introduction of Zero Emission Vehicles globally.”
